
This matter is before the Commission on respondent's failure to respond to Order No. 7795, served February 25, 2004. Order No. 7795 gave respondent until March 26, 2004, to: (1) file an amended tariff specifying current DC Medicaid rates and pay a \$25 filing fee and the \$100 civil forfeiture assessed in Order No. 7690; or (2) show cause why Certificate No. 763 should not be revoked. The order also gave respondent fifteen days to request a hearing. Respondent has yet to comply with Order No. 7795 or request a hearing.

Accordingly, Certificate No. 763 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Order No. 7795; provided, that the unpaid \$100 forfeiture assessed in Order No. 7690 and the unpaid \$100 annual fee assessed for 2004 pursuant to Order No. 3601 shall remain due and payable; and further provided, that the unfiled 2003 annual report mandated by Commission Regulation No. 60-01 also shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 763 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 763 to the Commission.
