Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 569 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on April 16, 2004, and Certificate No. 569 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 7944, served April 19, 2004. Order No. 7944 also noted that respondent had neither paid the \$100 annual fee for 2004<sup>1</sup> nor filed its annual report for 2003.<sup>2</sup>

Respondent filed its annual report for 2003 on April 28, 2004, and paid the \$100 annual fee on May 4, 2004. Respondent also filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on May 19, 2004. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
