By application accepted for filing April 26, 2004, Project "Raffah" Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for ambulatory and wheelchair van service, including airport shuttle fares, one-way and roundtrip fares, and hourly charter rates with minimum charges.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 10, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 24, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 24, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's operations director, Michael Olufuwa, 7429 Hickory Log Circle, Columbia, MD 21045.
