By application accepted for filing May 27, 2004, All-Ways Transportation Service LLC, a District of Columbia limited liability company, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

Page 3 of the application indicates that applicant holds state passenger carrier authority. However, applicant did not include a copy of the license, certificate or registration (Exhibit F). Applicant will be directed to file Exhibit F.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than July 6, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 20, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 6, 2004, an original and four copies of Exhibit F.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 20, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Grea M. Neverson, 5314 - 5th Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20011.
