
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 463 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on June 11, 2004, and Certificate No. 463 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 8089, served June 14, 2004.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on June 10, 2004, and an acceptable \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on June 21, 2004. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
