
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 26 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$2 million primary and \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated without replacement on July 1, 2004, and Certificate No. 26 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 8133, served July 1, 2004.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on July 8, 2004, and an acceptable \$2 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on July 15, 2004. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
