
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 712 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

On July 7, 2004, the Commission received written notice canceling the WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent effective July 24, 2004. On July 27, 2004, having received no replacement, the Commission issued Order No. 8191, declaring Certificate No. 712 automatically suspended and directing respondent not to transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 712, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

Under Commission Regulation No. 58-07, a WMATC Insurance Endorsement may not be cancelled except on thirty days' written notice to the Commission. Thirty days from July 7 is August 6. Accordingly, Order No. 8191 is hereby rescinded.
