

Notice of this application was served on June 21, 2004, in Order No. 8116, and applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than July 6, 2004, and to file proof of publication and certain other documents no later than July 20, 2004. Respondent has yet to respond.

An application for a certificate of authority must be in writing, verified, and in the form and with the information that Commission regulations require.¹ Commission Regulation No. 54 requires applicants to complete and file the Commission's application form, publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish additional information as required by Commission order.² The form itself requires supporting exhibits. Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of One, LLC, trading as Bon Voyage, is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
