Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 302 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired on September 15, 2004, and has not been replaced. Certificate No. 302, therefore, is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02.

In addition, respondent has not filed its annual report for 2003.¹

Respondent shall have thirty days to file the necessary endorsement(s) and submit an annual report for 2003, or show cause why Certificate No. 302 should not be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 302, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That within thirty days, respondent shall file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and submit an annual report for 2003, or show cause why Certificate No. 302 should not be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

3. That respondent may file within fifteen days from the date of this order a request for oral hearing, indicating the grounds for the request, describing the evidence to be adduced and explaining why such evidence cannot be adduced without an oral hearing.
