
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 531 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired on September 14, 2004, without replacement, and Certificate No. 531 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 8268, served September 14, 2004. Order No. 8268 also noted that respondent had neither paid the \$100 annual fee for 2004¹ nor filed its annual report for 2003.²

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on September 15, 2004. Respondent filed its annual report for 2003 and paid the \$100 annual fee for 2004 on September 16, 2004. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
