By application accepted for filing September 14, 2004, Mohammad Asghar Choudry, a sole proprietor trading as Alexandria Limousine Service, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one minibus. Applicant's proposed tariff contains transfer rates and an hourly charter rate with a minimum charge.

Applicant's address is the same as that for Shamim's Sons, Inc., trading as Crescent Transportation Group, WMATC No. 630. Applicant will be directed to file a statement explaining applicant's relationship with Shamim's Sons, Inc. Applicant also will be directed to explain why Exhibit D, applicant's proof of trade name registration, lists a different address as applicant's principal place of business.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 19, 2004, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.


2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 2, 2004, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 19, 2004, an original and four copies of a statement that explains applicant's relationship with Shamim's Sons, Inc., trading as Crescent Transportation Group, WMATC No. 630.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 19, 2004, an original and four copies of a statement that explains why the business address in applicant's proof of trade name registration is different from the business address on page 2 of the application.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 2, 2004, and that copies must be served on applicant at 6418 Grovedale Drive, #202-A, Alexandria, VA 22310.
