
Certificate No. 178 was revoked in Order No. 8297, served September 24, 2004, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Respondent subsequently filed the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsements on October 1, 2004, and an application for reconsideration of Order No. 8297 on October 6, 2004.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within thirty days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. The application is timely but does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that respondent has filed the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsements, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 178.<sup>1</sup>
