These proceedings were initiated on September 27, 2004, in Order Nos. 8299 and 8300 for the purpose of investigating respondent's failure to file its annual report for 2003 and pay a \$100 annual fee for 2004. Together, the orders gave respondent thirty days to file the annual report, pay the annual fee, and pay a combined civil forfeiture of \$200 and fifteen days to request an oral hearing. The order stated that Certificate No. 371 would stand suspended and be subject to revocation without further proceeding upon respondent's failure to timely comply. Respondent has yet to respond.


Accordingly, Certificate No. 371 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Regulation No. 60-01 and Order Nos. 3601, 8299 and 8300; provided, that the unpaid 2004 annual fee, unfiled 2003 annual report and \$200 combined forfeiture shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 371 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and

c. surrender Certificate No. 371 to the Commission.
