

This matter is before the Commission on respondent's request to reinstate Certificate No. 593, which was revoked in Order No. 8426, served November 17, 2004, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to file a complete annual report for 2004 and pay a \$100 civil forfeiture in compliance with Regulation No. 60-01 and Order No. 8299. On November 19, 2004, respondent filed a complete report and paid the \$100 civil forfeiture, which respondent offers as grounds for reinstatement.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), a party to a proceeding affected by a final order or decision of the Commission may file within 30 days of its publication a written application requesting Commission reconsideration of the matter involved, and stating specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. Respondent's request for reinstatement was timely filed but does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. Considering that respondent has filed a complete report and paid the forfeiture, however, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 593.<sup>1</sup>
