By application accepted for filing December 23, 2004, Beatrice Uzomaka Uzoho, trading as Comcare Health Services Travelbee, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

The application fee was paid by check drawn on the account of Comcare Staffing Agency LLC. Applicant will be directed to explain her relationship with Comcare Staffing Agency.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than January 26, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 9, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than January 26, 2005, an original and four copies of a written statement explaining applicant's relationship with Comcare Staffing Agency LLC.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is February 9, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant at P.O. Box 2288, Bowie, MD 20718.
