By application accepted for filing January 21, 2005, Prime Executive Service Inc., a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with fifteen sedans, three vans, one limousine, and one SUV. Applicant's proposed tariff contains individual fares for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan National and Washington-Dulles International Airports, as well as to and from the District of Columbia.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 24, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 10, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is March 10, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's general manager, Umar Hayat, 4124 Walney Road, #L, Chantilly, VA 20151.
