By application accepted for filing January 27, 2005, Mustafa Izzeldin Mustafa, a sole proprietor trading as Securetra Services, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program. Applicant's Exhibit A indicates that applicant will commence operations with a 7-passenger van that applicant owns, but the requisite copy of the vehicle registration is not attached. Applicant will be directed to file a copy of the vehicle registration.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 24, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 10, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than February 24, 2005, five copies of the vehicle registration for applicant's van.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is March 10, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant at 3409 Nevius Street, Falls Church, VA 22041.
