Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 789 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on March 12, 2005, and was replaced with a \$2 million primary endorsement only. Certificate No. 789 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 8586, served March 14, 2005. Order No. 8586 also indicated that respondent's 2005 annual fee and 2004 annual report were overdue. Consequently, Order No. 8586 gave respondent thirty days to submit the necessary endorsement(s), file the 2004 report and pay the 2005 fee.

The statement regarding respondent's annual fee and report has since been determined to be in error, and respondent has since filed an acceptable \$3 million excess of \$2 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
