By application accepted for filing February 7, 2005, Marshall Heights Community Development Organization, Inc., a nonprofit District of Columbia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant proposes transporting passengers to and from its senior citizens facility and explains that "charges for this service will be charged under Medicaid" as approved by the District of Columbia Department of Mental Health (DCDMH). Applicant will be directed to file a copy of its contract with DCDMH.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 18, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 2, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 2, 2005, five copies of applicant's contract with the District of Columbia Department of Mental Health.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is

May 2, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's COO, Ronald L. Stubblefield, 3939 Benning Road, N.E., Washington, DC 20019.
