Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 865 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on March 26, 2005, without replacement, and Certificate No. 865 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 8616, served March 29, 2005. Order No. 8616 also noted that respondent had not filed its annual report for 2004.<sup>1</sup>

Respondent subsequently filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and an annual report for 2004. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
