By application accepted for filing April 12, 2005, applicant, AMNA Transit Services Inc., a Virginia corporation, seeks Commission approval to acquire Certificate No. 850 from Nagwa Mohamed Hamed, trading as AMNA Medical Care Transportation. Hamed has agreed to transfer Certificate No. 850 and other assets in exchange for a controlling interest in AMNA Transit Services Inc., a new carrier.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the District of Columbia Medicaid program.

Under Article XI, Section 11(a), of the Compact, a person may not transfer a certificate of authority unless the Commission approves the transfer as consistent with the public interest. The public interest analysis focuses on the acquiring party's fitness.¹

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 11, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 25, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is May 25, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Nagwa Mohamed Hamed, 3101 S. Manchester Street, Suite 519, Falls Church, VA 22044-2726.
