By application accepted for filing April 15, 2005, The Washington-McLaughlin Adult Day Care Center, a District of Columbia nonprofit corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains a roundtrip trip rate for the Center's daycare clients.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 25, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 8, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 8, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's administrator, Dr. Pauline P. Washington, 11505 Lottsford Terrace, Mitchellville, MD 20721.
