By application accepted for filing April 27, 2005, Family Logistics, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with five vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly rates. The proposed tariff also states that applicant will offer flat-rate airport shuttle service, but the airport shuttle rates are not specified. Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit B that specifies applicant's proposed airport shuttle rates.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 6, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 20, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 20, 2005, an amended Exhibit B that specifies applicant's proposed airport shuttle rates.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 20, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Perry Umoh, 2615 Cranapple Lane, Springdale, MD 20774.
