By application accepted for filing April 28, 2005, RIMS Center for Enrichment and Development, LLC, a Maryland limited liability company trading as RIMS Transportation Services, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the District of Columbia Medicaid program.

Attached to the application as Exhibit C is a Maryland certificate of good standing dated April 4, 2005. According to the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation website as of May 19, 2005, applicant is no longer in good standing. Applicant will be directed to file a certificate of good standing issued after May 19, 2005.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 6, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 20, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 20, 2005, a certificate of good standing issued by the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation after May 19, 2005.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 20, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's CEO, Yolanda Coleman, 5354 Sheriff Road, Capitol Heights, MD 20743.
