Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 277 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on June 1, 2005, without replacement, and Certificate No. 277 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02 as a result, as noted in Order No. 8754, served June 2, 2005.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$2 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and an acceptable \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on June 6, 2005. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
