By application accepted for filing May 25, 2005, Felicia E. Medlock, a sole proprietor, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one SUV. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for service under a contract with Wayson's Bingo.

Applicant's Exhibit A does not include the seating capacity of the SUV, nor does it contain a copy of the SUV vehicle registration card. Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit A which includes a vehicle list containing the make, model, seating capacity, and number of vehicles applicant will use initially and a copy of the vehicle registration.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 2, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. Applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2005, an original and four copies of an amended Exhibit A which includes a vehicle list containing the make, model, seating capacity, and number of vehicles applicant will use initially and a copy of the vehicle registration.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 16, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant, Ms. Felicia E. Medlock, 14 Jefferson Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20011.
