By application accepted for filing May 31, 2005, GBTC (God Bless The Children) LLC, a District of Columbia limited liability company, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains flat fares for one-way transfers of groups, individual passengers, and passengers from government agencies.

Applicant's mandatory Exhibit C, a certificate of good standing from the District of Columbia Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs is dated April 8, 2005. Applicant will be directed to file one that is current.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 2, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2005, an original and four copies of a current certificate of good standing from the District of Columbia Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 16, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Charlene Crockett, 510 Peabody Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20011.
