By application accepted for filing May 31, 2005, Tech Systems, Inc., a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two minibuses. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for service under a contract with the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum.

Applicant's mandatory Exhibit C, a certificate of good standing from the Virginia State Corporation Commission is dated January 10, 2005. Applicant will be directed to file one that is current.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 2, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 16, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's President and CEO, Ms. Nancy S. Blethen, 6070 Deer Ridge Trail, Springfield, VA 22150.
