By application accepted for filing July 7, 2005, Dillon, Inc., a Maryland corporation trading as Perfedia Sedan and Limousine Seviles, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one limousine. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly group charter rates with a minimum charge, and a flat rate for vehicle transfers, with additional charges for airport transfers. It is not clear whether applicant's transfer rate applies to individuals or groups or whether the rate applies to one-way or roundtrip service. Also, applicant's proposed transfer rates would apply to some trips that extend beyond the Metropolitan District. Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit B.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 2, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 16, 2005, an original and four copies of an amended Exhibit B which indicates whether applicant's transfer rate applies to individuals or groups, indicates whether the transfer rate applies to one-way or roundtrip service, and excludes trips conducted outside of the Metropolitan District.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 16, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's President, Slatel W. Dillon, 2407 Brooks Drive, Suitland, MD 20746.
