By application accepted for filing June 24, 2005, Transport U LLC, a Maryland limited liability company trading as Transport-U, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for one-way transfers with an additional charge for extra passengers.

Applicant proposes doing business under the trade name, "Transport-U", which the record shows is registered to applicant's co-owner, David Harry, instead of applicant. Applicant will be directed to file proof that ownership of the trade name "Transport-U" has been transferred to Transport U LLC.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 17, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 31, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 31, 2005, five copies of proof that the ownership of the trade name, "Transport-U", has been transferred to Transport U LLC.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is

August 31, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's executive director, Barbara A. Harry, 7916 Bounding Bend Court, Rockville, MD 20855.
