By application accepted for filing July 11, 2005, Andyson Healthcare Services, a Maryland partnership, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

The application shows that Isaac Egbe, one of applicant's partners, has registered with the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation to conduct business under a trade name that is identical to applicant's name. To avoid confusion, applicant will be directed to submit proof to this Commission that the trade name "Andyson Healthcare Services" is no longer registered to Mr. Egbe.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 17, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 31, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 31, 2005, an original and four copies of proof from the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation that the trade name "Andyson Healthcare Services" is no longer registered to Isaac Egbe.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 31, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Isaac Egbe, 15108 Jennings Lane, Bowie, MD 20721.
