Case No. AP-2005-113

By application accepted for filing June 9, 2005, Transcom, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver. Applicant has also filed an application for temporary authority in Case No. AP-2005-114.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans and three sedans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for service under a contract with the United States Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

The record in this case indicates that applicant has contracted to provide transportation services to several government agencies. An affidavit accompanying the application in this proceeding refers to three government contracts, including with the Department of the Navy and the Transportation Security Administration. Applicant shall be directed to file with the Commission a copy of each contract currently in effect, in which applicant agrees to provide transportation services.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than August 17, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 31, 2005, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 31, 2005, a copy of each contract currently in effect, including all exhibits and attachments, in which applicant agrees to provide transportation services.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 31, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Yoon S. Shin, 14905 Finegan Farm Drive, Darnestown, MD 20874.
