Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 691 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired on August 1, 2005, and has not been replaced. Certificate No. 691, therefore, is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02.

In addition, respondent has not paid the \$100 annual fee for 2005.<sup>1</sup>

Respondent shall have thirty days to file the necessary endorsement(s) and pay the annual fee for 2005, or show cause why Certificate No. 691 should not be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 691, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That within thirty days, respondent shall file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the annual fee of \$100 for 2005, or show cause why Certificate No. 691 should not be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.
