This matter is before the Commission on respondent's response to Order No. 8844, served July 22, 2005, which directed respondent to pay a \$750 civil forfeiture within thirty days for knowingly and willfully violating Article XI, Section 6(a) of the Compact. On August 16, respondent tendered a cashier's check payable to the Commission for \$750.

In accordance with Commission Order No. 8844, Certificate of Authority No. 712 is hereby reinstated subject to a one-year period of probation, such that a willful violation of the Compact, or of the Commission's rules, regulations or orders, during the period of probation shall constitute grounds for immediate suspension and/or revocation of Certificate No. 712 without further proceedings, regardless of the nature and severity of the violation.
