By application accepted for filing June 27, 2005, A Ace Bus Charter, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two motor coaches.

Applicant failed to attach an Exhibit B to its application. Each application for operating authority submitted to this Commission must contain a description of proposed service and proposed rates. Applicant shall be directed to file with the Commission an Exhibit B, which includes a description of proposed service and proposed rates for transportation covered by its application.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than September 16, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 30, 2005, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 30, 2005, an Exhibit B, which includes a description of proposed service and proposed rates for transportation covered by its application.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is September 30, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Chun Y. Chung, 7535 Montevideo Road, Jessup, MD 20794.
