By application accepted for filing July 29, 2005, McCloud's Professional Limousine Service, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one sedan and two limousines. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly group charter rates with a minimum charge and flat rates for transfers between points in the Metropolitan District, including transportation to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport and Washington-Dulles International Airport.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than September 16, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 30, 2005, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is September 30, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's CEO, Miguel McCloud, 712 Haack Place, Upper Marlboro, MD 20774.
