By application accepted for filing August 16, 2005, Awolo Services Incorporated, a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains rates for transportation under the District of Columbia Medicaid program. The proposed tariff also indicates that applicant will perform non-Medicaid transportation, but does not include any rates for this service. Applicant will be directed to submit an amended Exhibit B which includes rates for both its Medicaid and non-Medicaid transportation.

Applicant's mandatory Exhibit C, a certificate of good standing from the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation is dated February 3, 2005. Applicant will be directed to file one that is current.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than September 16, 2005, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 30, 2005, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 30, 2005, a certificate of good standing from the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation dated after April 15, 2005.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 30, 2005, an amended Exhibit B which includes rates for both its Medicaid and non-Medicaid transportation.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is September 30, 2005, and that copies must be served on applicant's director, Dumazov Austin Kwentua, 6806 Furman Parkway, Riverdale, MD 20737.
