Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 838 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent was cancelled on July 20, 2005, effective September 8, 2005, and has not been replaced. Certificate No. 838, therefore, is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02. Also, respondent has not filed his 2004 annual report.<sup>1</sup> Respondent shall have thirty days to file the necessary endorsement(s) and submit a 2004 annual report, or show cause why Certificate No. 838 should not be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 838, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That within thirty days, respondent shall file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and submit an annual report for 2004, or show cause why Certificate No. 838 should not be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.
