

Section One : Rules and Regulations



1. Application of Tariff

The rules, regulations, rates, and charges, set forth herein, apply in connection with the provision of all charter services authorized to be provided by Szabo Faris LLC T/A Drive Me pursuant to Certificate of Authority No. 1999 issued in Case No. AP-2012-152.

2. Availability of Equipment

Charges named herein are based on vehicles being furnished of sufficient seating capacity and luggage capacity to accommodate the chartering party but carrier reserves the right, when operating conditions so require, to furnish vehicles of greater capacity, charges to be based on the capacity of vehicle ordered.

3. Objectionable Persons

The carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport a person or persons under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, or who is incapable of taking care of his self or herself, or her shows belligerent or abusive or unlawful or inappropriate or requests the driver to disobey laws, rules, or regulations, including but not limited to those pertaining to traffic.

4. Baggage

- a. Liability for loss or damage to baggage will be limited to \$50 (fifty dollars) for each individual.
- b. Carrier reserves the right to limit baggage to carrying capacity of vehicle.

5. Animals or Birds

Animals or birds will not be carried except seeing eye dogs accompanying their master.

6. Carrier Liability

- a. The carrier will not be liable for delays caused by the Act of God, public enemies, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incident to a state of war, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, snow storms, and other conditions beyond its control and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any points at a specified time. The carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agents and employees, but same is not guaranteed.
- b. If an Act of God, public enemies, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incident to a state of war, accidents, breakdowns, bad conditions of the road, snow storms, and other conditions beyond its control make it, in the opinion of the carrier, inadvisable to operate vehicles, either from the place of origin or any point en route, the carrier shall not be liable therefor, or be caused to be held for damages for any reason whatsoever.

7. Power of Agents

No agent or other employee shall have the authority to change or deviate from the rates, charges, or rules and regulations contained herein.

8. Damage to Equipment

a. Vehicles offered for service are carefully inspected by the carrier prior to assignment to such service. Any damage to seats, windows, sheet metal, or any other equipment, switch gear, or parts of the vehicle which is inflicted by any member of the chartering party shall be the responsibility of the chartering party and the costs to the carrier for the repair of such damage shall be paid by the chartering party.

b. A cleanup fee for damage to the interior or the cost of parts and labor cost to repair or replace interior components of the vehicle caused by vomiting or spills or sickness or injury or behavior or accident will be assessed and charged to the client when applicable with a minimum fee of \$250 for professional interior cleaning and detail.

9. Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in any vehicle.

Section Two : Charges for Executive Sedan Service

1. Application of Charges in this Section

The charges in this section shall apply to the transportation of passengers in vehicles with a seating capacity of five (5) including the driver and four (4) passengers.

2. Point to Point Charges

The following charges will be assessed on a per vehicle per trip basis for transportation with the Metropolitan District between the names points shown below, subject to other rules and regulations. Where no rates are shown between particular points, hourly rates as detailed in a subsequent section shall apply.

3. Hourly Charges

Except where point to point charges are published, charges for transportation between points in the Metropolitan District will be assessed for each vehicle chartered, per hour or portion thereof, subject to the minimum charges per vehicle shown below when the hourly charges do not otherwise equal that amount, subject to "Travel Time" charges and subject to other rules and regulations contained herein.

Five (5) Passenger Luxury Sedan
Rate for First Hour: \$69
Rate for Each Additional Hour: \$69

3.a. Time is to be calculated from the time the vehicle leaves the carrier's garage at the beginning of the charter trip until it returns to the carrier's garage at the conclusion of the charter trip.

3.b. A 15% driver gratuity will be added to the charges shown above.

3.c. A 20% surcharge will be added to all services commencing between 12:00 am and 5:00 am.

3.d. All applicable parking and toll fees will be added to all services.

3.e. A \$25 surcharge will be added to all services between 2:00 pm Friday and 11:59 pm Sunday on Memorial Day and Labor Day Weekends.

3.f. In honor of the holidays, service is not offered on Christmas Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Independence Day.

4. Cancellation Charges

A cancellation charge equal to the trip cost will be charged for any cancellation made less than 2 hours before the scheduled pick up time.

5. No Show Charges

A no show charge equal to the trip cost plus applicable waiting time plus an 18% service fee will be charged when the passenger fails to show at the designated location

6. En Route Stops

At the passenger's request, the vehicle will make stops en route to a destination. An additional charge of 1.00 per minute will be assessed for such stops.

7. Waiting Time

Carrier shall impose a charge of \$1.00 per minute for all waiting time after the free time period described below.

Note: For airport pickups a \$10 Meet and Greet fee includes 15 minutes wait time from scheduled arrival time.

8. Payment in U.S. Currency

All charges reflected in this tariff shall be calculated and paid in United States currency by cash or major credit cards.
