**I. SERVICE INFORMATION**

The rates, charges, rules and regulations contained herein apply to:

The transportation of passengers over irregular routes on an irregular schedule, between points in the Counties of Fairfax, Arlington, Prince George's, Montgomery Counties, Dulles International Airport, Cities of Alexandria, Falls Church and all political subdivisions located in the above listed areas, and District Of Colombia.

RESTRICTIONS: Vehicles having a seating capacity of no more than 10 passengers including the driver.

**II. RATES AND CHARGES**

A. The carrier will charge the following amounts for a one-way trip to and from the following points:

B. Possible additional charges over and beyond transport fees if applicable:

- a) cleaning charge: If, in the carrier's reasonable opinion, any passenger makes dirty or soils the vehicle and causes the carrier not to be able to continue further immediate use of the vehicle, a cleaning charge of \$150 will be assessed against that passenger or passengers who will be held both separately and collectively responsible.
- b) damage charge: Vehicles are inspected carefully by carrier prior to each trip. A rider will be given a form and asked to sign a document confirming that there are or are not any current damages prior to their trip. Any damage to seats, windows, equipment or any other parts of the vehicle which is caused by any passenger(s) shall be the responsibility of that passenger(s) and the costs to carrier for any and all repairs of such damages shall be forwarded to and paid by the passenger(s) responsible.
- c) Tolls, fees and special charges: The charges herein for any special tolls do not include bridge, ferry, tunnel, or highway tolls, entrance fees or charges for special licenses or permits. An additional charge will be assessed for the actual cost of such tolls, fees or special charges.

C. Collection of Charges

All charges for carrier transports are payable in advance. All payments must be in the form of cash, certified check, VISA or MasterCard. Personal checks will not be accepted by the discretion of the owner. A \$35.00 fee will be charged for any personal checks returned by the passenger. Any payments canceled that were paid by a credit card will also be assessed a fee of \$50.00 and will incur additional cost of all payments not received before 30 days of the original pay date. If full payment is not received by the 30<sup>th</sup> day then the carrier holds the right

to seek any and all legal channels to recover all monies owed to the carrier by the passenger(s).

### III. RULES AND REGULATIONS

#### A. Baggage

- a) Baggage will be checked at the discretion of the passenger.
- b) Any and all personal baggage, musical instruments, athletic equipment, and other personal belongings that can be fully contained in the carrier's vehicle is the sole responsibility of the passenger. The carrier is not responsible for damages to any personal items that the passenger chooses to check to be placed in the trunk or storage area of the carrier's vehicle. The personal belongings will be transported in the custody of the passenger at no additional charge.
- c) Liability for loss or damage of baggage will be limited to Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each passenger if such loss is due to the fault or negligence of the carrier.

### III. RULES AND REGULATIONS (continued)

#### B. Objectionable Persons

Carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport any passenger who appears to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs that would deem the passenger(s) a danger or nuisance to the carrier/driver or other passengers.

The aforementioned rule does not apply to anyone who is ill outside of the control of their actions and is accompanied by a caregiver to assist said passengers.

#### C. Animals

No animals of any type will be carried, except seeing-eye dogs accompanying their master.

#### D. Carrier's Liability

a. The carrier will not be held responsible for any of the following reasons for delay in transporting the passenger(s) according to the set schedule: Acts of God, law enforcement, pedestrian blockades of any kind, bad/unsafe, but not limited to (snow, hard rain, ice storm, hurricanes etc.) and all weather related delays outside the control of the carrier. The carrier will do its best to depart and or arrive according to the scheduled time, but it is not guaranteed.

b. If for any reason the carrier finds it necessary to cancel the proposed trip due to any unsafe or hazardous reasoning, the carrier will not be held liable if any of the aforementioned reasoning become applicable to that reasoning in addition to all others that may cause a delay or cancellation of services.
