Pursuant to Section 4(a), Article XII, Title II, Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact, Diamond Tours, Inc., Washington, D. C., seasonably filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity, said certificate to authorize such transportation as it was bona fide performing on March 22, 1961, the effective date of the Compact.

It appears that Diamond Tours was bona fide engaged in, and is entitled to a certificate to authorize, the transportation set forth below. In all other respects the application should be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 2 be, and it is hereby, granted to Diamond Tours, Inc., to transport passengers for hire as follows:

A. IRREGULAR ROUTE SIGHTSEEING OPERATION:

Passengers, and their baggage, on round-trip sightseeing or pleasure tours over irregular routes, restricted to traffic originating and terminating at Washington, D. C.

- (1) From Washington, D. C., to Alexandria, Arlington National Cemetery, and Mount Vernon, Virginia, and return.
- (2) Within the District of Columbia.

B. IRREGULAR ROUTE CHARTER OPERATION:

Passengers, and their baggage, in charter operations over irregular routes, restricted to traffic originating at Washington, D. C.,

(1) From Washington, D. C., to Alexandria, Arlington National Cemetery, and Mount Vernon, Virginia, and return.

(2) Within the District of Columbia.

2. That in all other respects, the application be, and it is hereby, denied.
