

On September 7, 1962, the Commission issued Order No. 194, granting temporary authority to the A. B. & W. Transit Company to pick up and discharge passengers between the Woodrow Wilson Bridge and the Naval Research Laboratory in Southwest Washington, D. C., upon and along its Culmore-Alexandria-Washington Line, WMATC File No. 402.

The Commission, on its own motion, has decided to reopen this proceeding for it appears that the authority issued should be modified to restrict A. B. & W. Transit Company from intra-District operations on this route.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the temporary authority issued in Order No. 194 be, and it is hereby, modified to restrict the A. B. & W. Transit Company from performing intra-District operations within the District of Columbia, along and upon its Culmore-Alexandria-Washington Line, WMATC File No. 402.
