Pursuant to Section 4a, Article XII, Title II of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact, Airport Transport, Inc. and Airport Transport Incorporated of Virginia seasonably filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

Protests to the application have been filed by Montgomery Charter Service, Inc., the Washington, Virginia and Maryland Coach Company, Inc., D. C. Transit, Inc., A. B. & W. Transit Company, Diamond Tours, Inc., and the Gray Line, Inc. Petition to intervene has been filed by Henry G. Bartsch, T/A, Airport Dispatching Service. In order to determine the bone fides of the transportation stated in said application the Commission is of the opinion that a hearing should be held on this matter. The Commission is of the further opinion that a pre-hearing conference should be held for the purpose of determining the issues, consolidating the parties who have like interests, and fixing a schedule of procedure to be followed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That an informal pre-hearing conference be held in the Commission's Offices, at 1801 North Moore Street, Arlington, Virginia, on the 4th day of December, 1962 at 9:30 a.m. for the purpose of determining the issues, consolidating the parties who may have like interests, and fixing a schedule of procedure to be followed. The protestants and the intervenor must be present at said pre-hearing conference in order to participate further in this proceeding.

2. That the date of hearing be set by the presiding officer at the conclusion of the pre-hearing conference.
