Davis, d/b/a White-Way Sightseeing Tours Company, has filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to engage in the following operations in addition to the authority granted by this Commission by virtue of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 3:

IRREGULAR ROUTES:

Special Operations:

Round trip or one-way, sightseeing or pleasure tours:

From motels located in that portion of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit District situated in the Commonwealth of Virginia to the District of Columbia and return to the motels in Virginia.

RESTRICTION: Restricted to the transportation of passengers who have made prior arrangements for sightseeing tours conducted pursuant to the authority granted by Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 3, held by Archie B. Davis, d/b/a White-Way Sightseeing Tours Company.

The applicant's attorney of record in this proceeding is Mr. L. Lee Bean, Bean, Sizemore & Harper, 2045 - 15th Street, North, Arlington, Virginia.

The Commission is of the opinion that this matter should be set for hearing.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, set for hearing on Friday, November 6, 1964, at 10:00 a.m., in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.

2. That the applicant publish notice of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Washington Metropolitan District at least once, twenty-five (25) days prior to said November 6, 1964.

3. That any person desiring to protest this application shall do so in writing with a copy to the attorney of record at least five (5) days prior to said November 6, 1964.
