By Order No. 414, served November 25, 1964, the Commission set the application of Atwood Transport Lines, Inc., for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to authorize regular route transportation of passengers between Washington, D. C., and Priest Bridge, Maryland, and between Lanham, Maryland, and the junction of Maryland Highways 450 and 197, to be heard on January 5, 1965.

Applicant has amended Part (2) of the route description in its original application to read as follows:

- (2) Between Lanham, Md. and junction unnumbered Maryland Highway and Maryland Highway 450, near Baldwin's Garage, Md.; and all intermediate points:

From Lanham, Maryland via Maryland Highway 564 to Bowie, Maryland, thence via Maryland Highway 197 to junction Maryland Highway 197 and Maryland unnumbered highway, thence via Maryland unnumbered highway to junction Maryland unnumbered highway and Maryland Highway 450, near Baldwin's Garage, and return over the same routes.

Order No. 414 ordered applicant to publish notice of the application and the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Washington Metropolitan District at least once twenty-five (25) days prior to said January 5, 1965. No such notice was published.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the hearing on the application as amended, scheduled for January 5, 1965, be continued and held on Tuesday, January 19, 1965, at 10:00 a.m., in the offices of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.

(2) That applicant publish notice of the application as amended and hearing thereon in a newspaper of general circulation in the Washington Metropolitan District, at least once, twenty-five (25) days prior to said January 19, 1965.

(3) That any person desiring to protest this application as amended shall do so, in writing to the Commission, with a copy to the attorney of record, at least five (5) days prior to said January 19, 1965.
