IN THE MATTER OF:

Establishing a Bus Stop on)
1st Street S. E. for Outbound)
W.M.A. Transit Company Bus Lines)

W.M.A. Transit Company outbound bus lines have been re-routed from Independence Avenue between 2nd Street S. W. and 1st Street S. E., Washington, D. C. The new route reaches Independence Avenue at 1st Street. The present bus stop is located on the south side of Independence Avenue, east of 1st Street.

Due to the re-routing, better service and better traffic flow would result if the bus stop were moved to the east side of 1st Street south of Independence Avenue.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That a bus stop be established at the following location:

On 1st Street, S. E.
East side, South of Independence Avenue

- (2) That the following bus stop be abolished:

On Independence Avenue, S. E.
South side, East of 1st Street

- (3) That this order become effective immediately upon the re-routing of the outbound bus lines.
