Ernest Keller, Jr., Waldorf, Maryland, has filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity, to operate as a common carrier by motor bus in the transportation of passengers and their baggage in charter party service between points within the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit District.

More specifically, authority is requested to institute this service over irregular routes in round trip charter operations beginning and ending in points in Prince Georges County, Maryland, on and east of that portion of U. S. Highway 301, extending from the Charles County-Prince Georges County line to junction Maryland Highway No. 382, and from points on and south of Maryland Highway 382 to unnumbered county road southeast of Croom Station, Maryland, and from points on and south of said unnumbered county road to the Patuxent River, and extending to points in Montgomery and Prince Georges Counties, Maryland, and political subdivisions of the State of Maryland located within said Counties, Alexandria and Falls Church, Virginia, and points in Arlington and Fairfax Counties, Virginia, the political subdivisions of Virginia located within those counties and that portion of Loudoun County, Virginia, occupied by the Dulles International Airport and political subdivisions of Virginia within the geographic area bounded by the outer boundaries of the combined area of said county, cities and airport.

The proposed operation will be year-round, not on schedule, but on call, and will be operated with three motor buses on the school-bus type.

The Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing is required in this matter.


**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:**
