
On October 8, 1965, the Commission entered Order No. 534, suspending the proposed tariffs previously filed in this proceeding, and deferring the use of the rates and charges stated therein, until January 15, 1966, unless otherwise ordered.

The record in this proceeding was closed on Wednesday, January 5, 1966, and the matter taken under advisement.

The Commission is of the opinion that a decision cannot be issued within the prescribed suspension period, and that, pursuant to Section 6(a)(2), said tariffs should be further suspended until February 5, 1966, unless otherwise ordered.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the tariffs described in Order No. 534 be, and they are hereby, further suspended until February 5, 1966, unless otherwise ordered.
