On November 23, 1965, Archie B. Davis, d/b/a White-Way Sightseeing Tours Company, filed Application No. 356 for authority to transfer its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 3, to White-Way Sightseeing Tours, Inc. This application was supplemented with the necessary exhibits in compliance with Rule 56 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

The necessary proof of publication, dated December 5, 1965, has been made in compliance with the regulations of the Commission. No protests have been received. The effect of the application is to allow the operating authority to follow the applicant from a proprietorship into an incorporated status.

The Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest that the certificate be transferred as requested by applicant.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That upon compliance by the applicant with all requirements of the Commission, including but not limited to insurance, tariffs, and safety, within thirty (30) days from the effective date of this Order, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 3, now held by Archie B. Davis, d/b/a White-Way Sightseeing Tours Company be transferred to White-Way Sightseeing Tours, Inc.
2. That unless compliance with the above paragraph is made by the applicant within the time prescribed herein, the grant of this transfer should be considered null and void.
