
On March 9, 1966, the Commission entered an interim order (No. 576) granting WMA Transit Company temporary authority to change its "T" and "Q" Routes in Carrollton, Maryland. Said Order stated why the Commission granted temporary authority to WMA Transit Company and declined to grant D. C. Transit System, Inc., temporary authority.

D. C. Transit System, Inc., has filed an application for reconsideration, in which it proposes that it be granted temporary authority to operate one of three suggested operations.

Having considered the application, its subsidiary papers, and the evidence adduced in both proceedings, the Commission is of the opinion that Order No. 576 is correct in every respect, that the interim authority issued therein is sufficient pending final decision, and that the application for reconsideration should be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of D. C. Transit System, Inc., for reconsideration of Order No. 576, be, and it is hereby, denied.
